

A letter from Pastor John



New technology is amazing! Advances in medical and auto technology are, by leaps and bonds, far advanced over innovative practices just ten years ago. Today, self-steering cars (scary) and washing machines that can be started remotely be cell phone are advanced enough to send retail costs through the roof. A few months ago, we bought a washing machine. The old one rattled and made grinding noises. The new one cleans clothes guite well, thank you, and it washes out food stains, but the technology has not produced anything that comes close to washing out anything more than food stains and yard dirt. If it could remove sins, the agitation of the device could create in us, not a clean heart but a fear of drowning, replacing liturgical confessions and baptismal fonts. If a minor sin registered 2 on a scale of 1-10, a short wash should do for cookie theft. If the sin scored 8 or 9, a prolonged and deeper wash, and a double rinse, should take care of the more aberrant behavior. The dry cycle could be more of a challenge. If you wanted to really fluff the load, and leave an indelible impression on the mind and body of a sinner, I would use small rocks in the dryer rather than tennis balls.

Overall, though, wouldn't you be kinder to yourself, less ruffled and tossed, to just confess in church on a Sunday morning?
